### Executive of Pathways

#### Executive Role

Decision making, overseeing and long-term focus level of the Association

#### Objectives

- To ensure a safe and comfortable environment for association members and visitors.
- To Identify talent and to facilitate the most appropriate pathway for that talent to develop.

#### Responsibilities

- Coordinate and oversee all activities relating to hockey development within the association.
- Utilise and facilitate senior and junior pathways.
- Support, promote and develop pathways for members of the association.
- Assess and understand opportunities that are available from Hockey NSW and WWCHA.
- Assist the representative coordinator to promote and organise representative opportunities for members of the association.
- Assist the Junior Coordinator to identify, promote and develop pathways for junior members of the association and to assist them in their junior programs.
- Facilitate a support network both within and outside the association to aid and develop pathways for members of the association.
- Attend association meetings to report on activities which they have overseen.

#### Relationships

- Reports to and liaises with the president and executive committee.
- Works closely with Junior Coordinator and Representative Coordinator.
- Liaises with Hockey NSW and WWCHA.

#### Accountability

- The Executive Pathways is accountable to the president and the executive committee.
- Provides reports to the committee when requested.
